GENERAL DETAILS

PARENT COMMUNICATIONS -

You will receive a text the week prior to your child's camp session from the Remind app. This will go to the cell phones listed for camper registration. We will use the Remind app to send logistical information about drop off and pick up and any reminders or details that need to be sent out during the week. You do not need to have the Remind app installed on your phone. If you do not want to be included in the text distribution list, please email director@poconoplateau.org. You can also opt out once you receive the introductory text.

During the camp week:

CAMP PHOTOS – We will provide a camp group photo for all campers at the end of the week at no additional charge.

CAMP STORE

Campers will have the opportunity to go to the camp store on Fridays. Parents can send money if they'd like on Friday and their counselor will hold on to it until store time. Campers can purchase ice cream, snacks, soda, t-shirts, sweatshirts, and other items. **General prices**: Soda \$1.00, candy \$1.00, ice cream novelties \$1.50-\$2.00, Tshirts \$18.00, sweatshirts \$30-\$40.

CAMPER COMMUNICATION

- Phone: Campers are not allowed to bring cell phones. Campers may not make or receive phone calls unless there is
 an emergency. The camp staff will be able to contact parents/guardians if necessary. We realize some campers are
 not used to this and if there is an issue with homesickness, we will permit the parent to communicate with the
 camper if needed using a camp or counselor phone.
- **Email:** We have an email address for overnight camp so campers can receive messages from their families. This is not something we plan to utilize for day camp since they will return home nightly.

SWIM EVALUATIONS

For the safety of all campers, it's important to determine swimming ability. Campers typically have swim evaluations with our lifeguards on Monday afternoons before waterfront time and will be put into one of three groups: beginner, intermediate, and advanced. All campers will wear a life jacket when on the Wibit (inflatable obstacle course).



WHAT TO BRING

We suggest putting your name on your luggage and sleeping bag. If you can, label your clothes with your name, as well.

Forms Needed:

All parents/guardians should complete the online health form for their camper prior to their first day of camp. You can do this in the same place you registered: https://poconoplateau.campbrainregistration.com/

If you need to bring medication, please bring the following with you on the first day of camp:

If applicable, Authorized Medical Release Form, signed by doctor. Bring medication in original container. This is only required if your child needs to bring an Epi Pen or Medication to camp.

Packing List: Bring a bag with the following:

- Bible (we have Bibles if needed)
- Reusable water bottle
- Beach Towel
- 1 extra change of clothes including socks
- Swimsuit (Please make a modest selection. Staff reserves the right to require swimmers with overly revealing swimsuits to wear a t-shirt.)
- Flashlight
- Sunscreen and bug repellent
- Hat (optional)

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Please NO cell phones, electronics, iPods, etc. These detract from the camp experience and should stay at home.
- No need to bring any food, we'll supply all the meals and snacks.
- Except on Fridays, no cash. Parents/Guardians can send money on Friday and the counselors will hold the money until campers go to the camp store on Fridays. This is not required.
- Because we believe that camp should be a safe place to play and grow, the Plateau does not allow weapons of any kind, use of controlled substances, or clothing with inappropriate language or pictures.
- Vaping among teenagers has become a growing issue in our society. Please note vaping and smoking are not tolerated
 at the Plateau. If a camper is seen using these, parents will be contacted, and we will discuss further action. We suggest
 parents check bags and back packs prior to dropping off their youth.



ARRIVAL/CHECK IN PROCEDURES

Campers will begin their morning in The Treehouse, which is our indoor space reserved for Day Camp. This space has air conditioning, sofas, toys, games, and crafts.

If your child will be late for any reason, please send a text to Carmen O'Shea at 470-314-1515.

BEFORE CARE DROP OFF: Parents/Guardians can drop off anytime between 7:30am and 9:00am. There will be signs directing you to the drop off loop. At drop off, on the first day of each week, a staff member will check to see if you have any balance due or paperwork needed. If you do, we will ask you to park and check in at our camp office. If you do not have any payment or paperwork, we will help your child from the car and take them to The Treehouse.

9AM DROP OFF: There will be signs directing you to the drop off loop. At drop off, on the first day of each week, a staff member will check to see if you have any balance due or paperwork needed. DEPARTURE/CHECK OUT PROCEDURES

Campers will end their day with a snack in The Treehouse. Pick up will be in the same location as morning drop off.

4pm PICK UP: Parents/Guardians can begin to form a line in the drop off/pick-up loop and we will dismiss campers at 4pm.

The first time you pick up, we will ask you to show your driver's license in the pick-up line. We will give you a pick-up sheet for future use that you can display on your windshield. Going forward, if you do not have your pick-up sheet displayed, we will ask you to provide your driver's license each time.

PLEASE BE SURE YOU COMPLETED YOUR AUTHORIZED PICK-UP INFORMATION in your camper's profile in our registration system. https://poconoplateau.campbrainregistration.com/. We will not release a camper to anyone not listed on your Authorized Pick Up List.

If you will be late for any reason, please send a text to Carmen O'Shea at 470-314-1515. Consistent late pick ups will result in the additional charge of the after-care fee.

AFTER CARE PICK UP: Parents/Guardians can pick-up anytime between 4:15pm and 5:30pm.

If you arrive anytime between 4:15pm and 5:15pm, please park in the lot by the maintenance area across the street from the drop off/pick up loop. Come into the camp office and they will radio staff to bring your child from their activity area.

If you arrive between 5:15 and 5:30, please come to the drop off/pick up loop by The Treehouse.

The first time you pick up, we will ask you to show your driver's license in the pick-up line. We will give you a pick-up sheet for future use that you can display on your windshield. Going forward, if you do not have your pick-up sheet displayed, we will ask you to provide your driver's license each time.

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
